Welcome to Lofland Montessori Private Nature Preschool. As parents feel free to feel at home here at our farm school.

Collaboration and mutual trust are the cornerstones of successful education. This document of information contains everything that is necessary to make your toddler feel at home and to set your mind at ease from all your uncertainties.

Communication between school and you as parents is indispensable. We see happiness and well-being of your toddler at the utmost importance. Feel free to discuss any uncertainty with the staff.

Read carefully and keep this document as you can refer to it at any time if you are uncertain about anything.

We depend on your cooperation and we assure you of our very best. We intend to always ensure the optimal overall development and happiness of your toddler.

MISSION

The school aims to establish a positive, Christian, loving, warm and safe atmosphere so that the toddler can develop optimally in all aspects of humanity.

THE NATURE OF ACTIVITIES

All activities are presented from a Christian life perspective, with the Bible as a guideline.

Toddlers learn that they are special and therefore all activities are offered to suit every child's level of development.

Although a structured program is offered, all activities are created that the toddler can print his own stamp on it. Creativity and originality are the starting point.

MONTESSORI CLASS ROTATION

Learners aged 2-3 / 3-4 and 4-5 years rotate classes. This rotation is between 3 classes. Math and Science class, Literacy and processing class and Art and Music and Physical class. Each of these classes are equipped with all resources and equipment needed to effectively and efficiently lead learners to explore and develop in each focus area.

Rotating classes helps keep our little ones interested and focused for longer due

to the change of scenery and lesson objective.

CURRICULUM

At Lofland Montessori Private Nature School, Afrikaans and English are the mediums of instruction. We do not have TVs in our classrooms as this is not beneficial for the development of our learners. We do use theme-based resources if needed that might be in the form of a video to watch. We use music, song, dance and reading.

BABIES AND TODDLERS FOCUS AREAS

Manipulative exercises:

A variety of exercises including threading, bead stringing and puzzles help toddlers develop hand-eye coordination.

Practical Life:

Material to help children to take care of themselves and to take care of the environment (house work), farming feeding our little animals and water our plants. Also having compassion and helping friends.

Language:

Development of language skills – spoken vocabulary – enrichment exercises that include reading books and other activities, including art and music,

The Montessori Directress and her assistant nurture the child's natural curiosity and love of learning.

PRE SCHOOLERS AGE 2 - 6

The primary goal of the Lofland Montessori School is to help each child reach full potential in all areas of life. The program promotes the development of intellectual, emotional, physical, creative, and social independence.

Children of different age groups have separate learning periods as well as periods where we they are different ages. The practical experience is priceless. The little ones observe how beautiful the older children work and try to copy them. The older children love to "play teacher" and by doing that they internalize the knowledge they already have. They also learn to take care of the little ones.

The children work individually with the material and develop at their own pace. While also having structured classes daily.

Our school has the Montessori characteristics:

- All materials are accessible, they have access to our library and Science Zone
- The materials are neat and orderly,
- Everything is complete and Subject orientated.
- The activities are graded from easy to difficult,

- Only purposeful activities are presented
- Freedom – Dr Montessori was an advocate of allowing the children freedom of movement in the school. The children are free to work at their own pace with materials they have chosen, either alone or with friends. The children have freedom within limits. There is a set of rules that should be obeyed. The children should have respect for each other and for the environment.

The teacher observes the children to determine which new activities may be introduced.

OUR 6 AREAS OF DEVELOPMENT

Practical Life: Practical life enhances the development of coordination, self-sufficiency and manipulative skills. They learn to take care of themselves, to take care of the environment, exercises of Grace and Courtesy and coordination of movement.

Sensorial: The Sensorial area allows children to order, classify and describe sensory impressions in relation to length, width, temperature, size, colour and more.

Language: The Language area includes development of speaking skills, writing, reading and grammar. We cover English, Afrikaans & Mandarin as an Extra subject.

Mathematics: The Mathematics area helps the children to recognise and internalise the concepts of numbers, symbols, sequencing and operations.

Gross Motor Development: The Gross Motor Development area assists children in developing crucial motor skills.

Cultural: In the Cultural area we cover the following subjects: Geography, Botany, Zoology, Art, Music, Science and Technology.

Gr R LEARNERS ARE INCLUDED IN THE PRIMARY AND DOES RECEIVE AN ALTERNATIVE INFORMATION BOOKLET

Our Gr R learners do Caps Rainbow Books as Gr 1 preparation.

Learning to read and write course places an emphasis on listening, speaking and reading. Students beginning their schooling journey will learn to blend sounds, decode unfamiliar words by breaking them down into sounds, and read a simple story.

SCHOOL FEES

School fees are paid in advance. It will be paid for 12 months of the year. School fees must be paid before the Third of each month.

An amount of R 1000,00 is required for registration.

The registration fee is payable regardless of whether the toddler attends the nursery school part-time or full-time.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

School uniforms are compulsory on Mondays and Thursdays. The rest of the week pupils are allowed to wear either their uniforms or comfortable clothing. Uniforms are available to purchase at the school.

Other days of the week please dress your child in comfortable clothes that may become "DIRTY". No-one can be held back from any game because of Mom who said, "I'm not getting dirty". (This causes emotional problems)

Please note our bicycle trail is off-road and your child will be dirty most days as we have an active approach to education.

Dress your child in basic T shirts nothing fancy.

In summer, shoes are not unnecessary. Please remember:

When it starts getting cooler in the morning and getting warmer clothes, make sure they have something underneath so that they can take off the sweater / jacket / sweat suit when it gets warm later at playtime.

Please remember to add sunblock for the toddlers in the summer.

PLEASE NOTE ALL PERSONAL BELONGINGS SHOULD BE MARKED:

- _ Shoes

- _ lunch boxes and lids
- _ bottles and lids
- _ Schoolbags, etc.

We try to teach the toddlers to keep all their belongings in their compartments. Please also pay attention and remind your toddler.

WHAT YOUR CHILDREN NEED:

- 1 set of clean clothes
- Extra pants (as you think are needed)
- Please remember the wet wipes and toilet paper at the beginning of each month

BIRTHDAYS

Every child's birthday is something special and a fuss is made on the day of his / her birthday.

We will be partying, and everyone is participating. Do not buy expensive eats, cake and / or ice cream is sufficient. If you want to make a package for each toddler, you are welcome. You as parent are welcome to attend the party.

We have a jumping castle that we use for the party time (if arrangements are made.

Here are some suggestions on what to bring.

MEDICATION

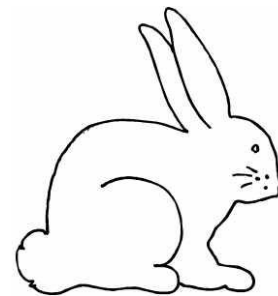
Remember that a toddler who is ill does not benefit at school and should stay home.

All medication must be given to the teacher. A note will be made against the fridge when the toddler must take the medication. Please write your toddler's name on the medication.

Important: Medication may not be left in the toddler's bag.

The provisions of the 1977 Health Act on the exclusion of a child from the school due to contagious disease stipulate that you as parent have the responsibility to:

- i) Notify the school of the infectious disease
- ii) Keep the toddler at home until he has recovered in order to attend school again.
- iii) Please notify us by email. A text message if your toddler is ill.



COMMUNICATION

Good communication between the home and the school is very important for a good relationships and peace of mind among toddlers, parents and teachers.

In the morning, the following communication opportunities can be used:

Accompany your toddler and hand him / her to the teacher. In this way you can discuss any problems with your toddler's teacher in the interests of your toddler (such as illness, a dad who is away due to working conditions, a bad night). This will enable the teacher to understand abnormal behavior and give extra attention.

Books: When you can't talk for themselves, please write a letter and ask your toddler to show it to the teacher.

Phone: The best time to call the school is between 08:00 and 08:45 and then again

12:15 and 13:30.

TEAMWORK

The teachers' most important means of communication are WhatsApp notifications. It sets out the following:

- The specific theme of the week we worked on
- Requirements the toddlers need
- Recommendations
- Events, dates and times

Please be punctual to:

i) Mark off the date and time on your calendar

ii) Answer slips can be filled in and returned (remember to keep the top information for yourself)

Toddlers are not allowed to go on outings if slips are not returned. Please keep to the prescribed dates.

Every parent has to purchase and cover a small booklet (A5 hard band) for his toddler with his / her name. The booklets come to school on Fridays and are then returned with a letter in it. Feel free to write any message in the book at all times. If the toddler gives the teacher the book, she can report back.

PROGRESS REPORTS

Evaluation of toddlers is done on a continuous basis. Every child 2 years and older receives a progress report at the end of each term. Parents can see what aspects of the toddler's development still need attention.
